Submissions must be the original work of the student. Each entry must include the student's name, phone number, school and school contact number. All entries are due on Friday, April 26, 2013.

All of the following must be submitted in order to be considered for the scholarship:

- 3. Submission (Essay, Poem or Song)
- 4. Recommendation Letter By School Faculty
- 5. Recommendation Letter By someone outside of high school community
