The “Play Like A Jet” Scholarship is available to **ALL** NYC Department of Education / PSAL Student Athletes who are graduating high school seniors that will be entering their first year of college in the Fall of 2013. The scholarship will go to the two students (one female and one male) who most personify the “Play Like A Jet” qualities in their submission.

The entry should demonstrate the qualities, expectations and focus listed above. Detail how these categories are demonstrated in your life as a student/athlete in the PSAL. The submission can be an essay, poem or song. Written submissions for the contest should be between 500 and 1000 words.

Submissions must be the original work of the student. Each entry must include the student’s name, phone number, school and school contact number. All entries are due on **Friday, April 25, 2014.**

All students submitting a scholarship form should be available for a recognition event on June 17, 2014 or June 18, 2014, should they be selected as a winner.

All of the following must be submitted in order to be considered for the scholarship:

- 1. Play Like A Jet Scholarship Information Form**
- 2. Transcript**
- 3. Submission (Essay, Poem or Song)**
- 4. Recommendation Letter – By School Faculty**
- 5. Recommendation Letter – By someone outside of high school community**
