Studies have shown that girls are dropping out of sports at $1\frac{1}{2}$ the rate that boys do by the age of 14, and by 17, more than half of girls will quit sports altogether.

In an effort to encourage and empower girls to continue in sports, HSS has partnered with espnW to create "*Keep Her in the Game*," a day-long conference featuring distinguished females from various disciplines in the sports industry.
