

INDIVIDUAL ACCESS PROGRAM – NEXT STEPS FOR INTERESTED STUDENTS

Interested Eligible Students:

1. [Eligible](#) students must first communicate with their school's Athletic Director their interest in playing for a sport not currently offered in the school's athletic program.
 - If you do not know your school's Athletic Director, search your school's athletic program name in the "Schools" tab on www.psal.org. Contact the principal if there is no assigned Athletic Director.
 - Students and families should contact their school's Athletic Director directly as their primary point of contact for all Individual Access Program related questions.
2. Student must complete and return the following forms to their home school's Athletic Director:
 - [Interscholastic Athletics Parental Consent Form](#)
 - [Interscholastic Sports Medical Form](#)
3. Your school's Athletic Director will provide the host-school assignment and tryout information. Host schools are currently mapped via the following parameters (in order):
 - a. **District** – existing in-district sports offerings
 - b. **Travel time** – amount of time from sending school address to host school address
4. Your school's Athletic Director will provide you with a copy of your completed [Interscholastic Athletics Parental Consent Form](#) and [Interscholastic Sports Medical Form](#) so you can provide the copy to the host-school Athletic Director or coach when you show up for tryouts.
5. Your school's Athletic Director will communicate the tryout outcome and any other relevant information.
