Visiting Team Spectator Policy

In order to ensure the proper ideals of sportsmanship, fair play and ethical conduct during athletic contests; please be advised of the following guidelines and procedures for games at Maspeth High School:

- Games begin at 4:30 p.m. (4:00 p.m. for outdoor sports) unless otherwise pre-arranged by the coaches and officials.
- Team members who arrive before their coaches will be asked to wait outside the ***Maspeth High School building entrance*** until coaches arrive. Coaches are to sign-in at the front desk and go directly with their team to the gymnasium.
- Only coaches, team members and listed managers (*retrieved from PSAL team page*) will be admitted into the gymnasium. **Maspeth coaches will provide our Safety Agents as well as Supervisor in charge with the roster of the visiting team.**
- ***NO SPECTATORS*** from visiting schools will be admitted *except* for parents, player's siblings accompanied by a parent, college coaches, scouts, school staff and PSAL league personnel. Appropriate identification will be requested. ***There may be an admission fee to spectators.***
- All coaches are responsible for supervising their teams in the visiting locker room area as well as the gymnasium.
- All team members and managers must be escorted when exiting the gymnasium and school building.
- All student-athletes, coaches and spectators should refrain from the use of profanity or vulgar displays, practice good sportsmanship toward each other and game officials and adhere to all rules and regulations of conduct instituted by the Team, Maspeth High School, and the Chancellor.
