## **Spectator Policy**

In an effort to regulate and effectively supervise our home basketball games, we have instituted the following procedures.

- 1. Players and a maximum of three managers will be admitted to the building when accompanied by the coach with ID. Please use the 350 Grand Street entrance.
- 2. Teams may not enter before 3:45 pm due to classes still in session.
- 3. The coach must actively supervise the team at all times.
- 4. The visiting spectators are not permitted and will not be permitted. Only parents of players will be permitted.
- 5. Cheerleaders and boosters may not be brought into the building.
- 6. Anyone leaving the building after being admitted will not be re-admitted.
- 7. Food and/or beverages may not be brought into or consumed in the building. (Only water bottles on the bench.)
- 8. Only players and coaches are allowed on the gymnasium floor.
- 9. Locker room facilities are available but we recommend that students do not bring any valuable with them.
- 10. Any player or spectator that fails to adhere to reasonable standards or behavior and good sportsmanship will be escorted out of the building. This includes the use of profanity and the berating of players, coaches, officials or other spectators.
- 11. At the completion of the game, the coach must accompany team members out of the building.
