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Visiting Team & Spectator Policy

- 1. Check PSAL website for starting times (<u>www.PSAL.org</u>).
- 2. Visiting team members who arrive before their coaches will be asked to wait outside the building entrance. Visiting team will be permitted when adult coach is present.
- 3. The visiting team with coaches must report to, sign-in and present valid photo ID (students should have their school ID) to the School Safety Agent (SSA) at the front desk, proceed through scanning and go directly with their team to the gym.
- 4. Only coaches, team members, and managers that are listed on the PSAL website will be admitted into the gymnasium by the School Safety Agent. Visiting cheerleaders and boosters are not permitted at athletic events in our building.
- 5. During home games and athletic events—spectators from either team will not be allowed, except for; parents/guardians, college coaches, scouts, and school staff. Valid photo ID must be presented.
- 6. During practices—only the student athletes, student managers, and coach/coaches on the team roster may attend. No exceptions.
- 7. The school reserves the right to deny access to any visitor if we deem access would adversely affect a student's or staff member's safety or wellbeing.
- 8. Eating, drinking and gum chewing are not allowed at any athletic event. Water is permitted.
- 9. All coaches are responsible to bring their own First Aid supplies and AED.
- 10. Coaches must actively supervise their team at all times. At the conclusion of the game team members, managers and spectators from both teams must be escorted out of the building by their respective coaches.
- 11. Both teams are expected to clean up after themselves. Please do not leave garbage—cups, bottles, paper, etc. on the floor.
- 12. It is expected that all participants—players, coaches, team managers as well as officials, scouts, college coaches, and parents/guardians will conduct themselves appropriately.
- 13. Anyone (including players, student managers, spectators, parents/guardians) who does not adhere to acceptable behavior during the event will be asked to leave.
- 14. All PSAL policies and procedures will be enforced including, but not limited to, the PSAL's Profanity Policy.
