



2021-2022 Brooklyn Technical High School Spectator Policy: UPDATED as of 12/8/21

In order to be in compliance with current COVID guidelines/restrictions and to best ensure the health and safety of all athletes and staff, we have put the current policy in place for the 2021-2022 school year:

1. Brooklyn Tech H.S. will **ONLY allow TWO spectators per Brooklyn Tech student-athlete**. All other outside spectators will not be allowed into the event.
2. Brooklyn Tech students are not being granted access to these events at this time.
3. Spectators that are allowed to attend the event must follow these guidelines or will be asked to leave:
 - a. Social distancing of at least three feet in the bleachers must be adhered to.
 - b. Everyone must wear a mask at all times over their mouth and nose.
 - c. Present proof of vaccination to enter the building.
 - d. Fill out the Health Screening and present the results to enter.
 - e. Fill out the Google Form below by 12:00PM of the date of the PSAL event. If it is not completed by noon the day of the event, then entry will not be granted. Security will check you in at the door. Enter through the southeast security door on South Elliott Place.
4. Due to capacity restrictions, only Gym 1 and the Pool can have spectators. Each location under the CDC and DOE guidelines can only hold 50 people per site. All other locations for PSAL events cannot have spectators due to not meeting the criteria set by the CDC and DOE guidelines.
 - a. Spectators in Gym 1 are limited to the bleachers under the windows, opposite teams/players
 - b. Spectators in the pool must remain in the seating/benched gallery area.
5. Since our outdoor sports are played on public fields, spectators are allowed, but masks, social distancing, and all other COVID protocols are required and will be enforced.
6. The expectation is for all coaches, athletes, and officials to always wear their masks, except for mask breaks. All coaches should supervise and enforce this rule.
7. Coaches, players, and officials may not bring siblings, children, or other family members to the indoor events. **Only coaches, players, and managers listed on the PSAL website will be granted access to the building and be allowed on the sidelines.**
8. Locker rooms are not available for visiting teams in the building. Bathrooms will be available located outside each of the gymnasiums. Visiting teams, coaches, and officials should come dressed from school or home.
9. All players, coaches, managers, and officials must enter Brooklyn Tech HS via the entrance in the middle of South Elliott Place, the entrance which is opposite 45 South Elliott Place.

Failure to adhere to these guidelines will result in being removed from the event. No exceptions.
